

1. Introduction

Welcome to Traktionssysteme Austria. The safety of our visitors and employees is of high importance to us. Please observe and practice the following safety instructions.

The visitor badge you were handed at the reception desk should be clearly visible to anyone and must be worn at all times.

Please do not leave the visitor group and do not lose touch with your TSA contact person during your entire stay.

2. Rules of conduct



2.1 ACCESS

Admittance to the manufacturing facility and access to machinery and equipment is strictly prohibited without explicit approval of your TSA contact person.



2.2 MARKED PATHS

Do not leave the marked paths without permission of your TSA contact person.



2.3 DO NOT TOUCH

Do not touch machinery or material without permission of your TSA contact person.



2.4 PHOTOGRAPHY

Filming and photography is prohibited!



2.5 TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

The Austrian Road Traffic Act (StVO) shall apply accordingly. The maximum speed limit must be adhered to. Parking is permitted only in designated parking areas.



2.6 SMOKING

Smoking is permitted only in designated outdoor smoking cabins at entrance 3 and 4.

2.7 PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT



During your entire stay at the manufacturing facility, wear sturdy footwear along the marked traffic routes and wear safety foot protection when off these paths.



It's obligatory to wear a safety vest during your stay at the manufacturing facility.



Use ear protection in designated areas and where appropriate.



Wear eye protection in case of flying sparks or in designated areas.

3. Hazard information



3.1 SUSPENDED LOADS

Stay away from under suspended loads! In the event of crane work, please maintain a sufficient safety distance and wait until passing is approved by the crane operator.



3.2 SURFACES

Pay attention to hot surfaces!



3.3 CLOSED AREAS

Keep off closed areas and use the marked paths.



3.4 FACTORY TRAFFIC

Always pay attention to the traffic while on streets and paths across the company premises, particularly when close to doors of the production hall.

4. Emergency

What to do in case of a fire, an accident or other hazard:

4.1 EMERGENCY CALL



Notify first aiders and the responsible employees of Traktionssysteme Austria.

4.2 ESCAPE



Leave danger zone and warn persons at risk. In the event of a fire, attempt to fight the fire by using an extinguisher. Escape route maps are displayed on several spots across the factory site.

In the event of an emergency, proceed to the designated assembly points, accompanied by your TSA contact person. In case you are alone, please use the assembly point at the main entrance reception. The assembly points are listed under point 6 (site plan).

4.4 AUTHORITIES

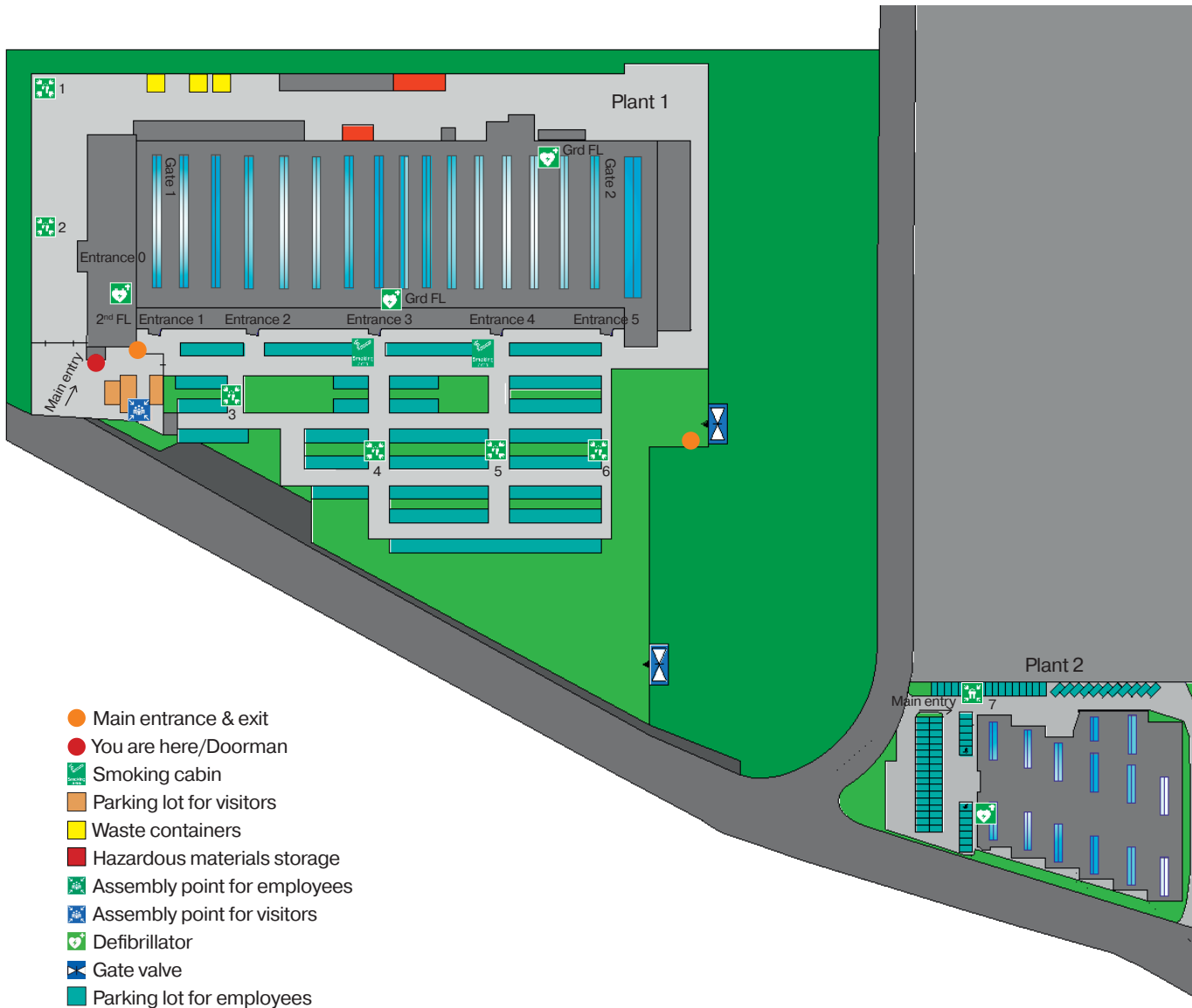


Instructions by rescue forces, fire protection officers and occupational safety staff must be followed!
